October is Domestic Violence Awareness Month

Domestic Violence occurs when an individual gains or maintains power and control over their intimate partner or relative.

Homicide is one of the leading causes of death of women under 44 years of age, with nearly half of the victims killed by a current or former intimate partner, according to the CDC. This equates to 2,000 to 3,000 women a year killed by their partners.

More than 1 in 3 women and more than 1 in 4 men have experienced rape, physical violence, and/or stalking by an intimate partner, according to <u>a report</u> released by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

(VOCA) Funding Cut

Across the state level, agencies that serve survivors of violence were cut over 48% in the federal Violence of Crime Act (VOCA) program. Haven House was cut resulting in a loss of \$145,000 for our VOCA Fiscal Year 2023/2024. With funding cuts, families fleeing violence will be impacted. This funding cut \$50,000 from our transitional housing program resulting in fewer families we can help shield in their own homes as they transition from our shelter services. The remaining \$95,000 was cut on staff wages, benefits, and direct client needs such as food. We are writing grants to get us to make up for the funding cuts.
