What is Human Trafficking

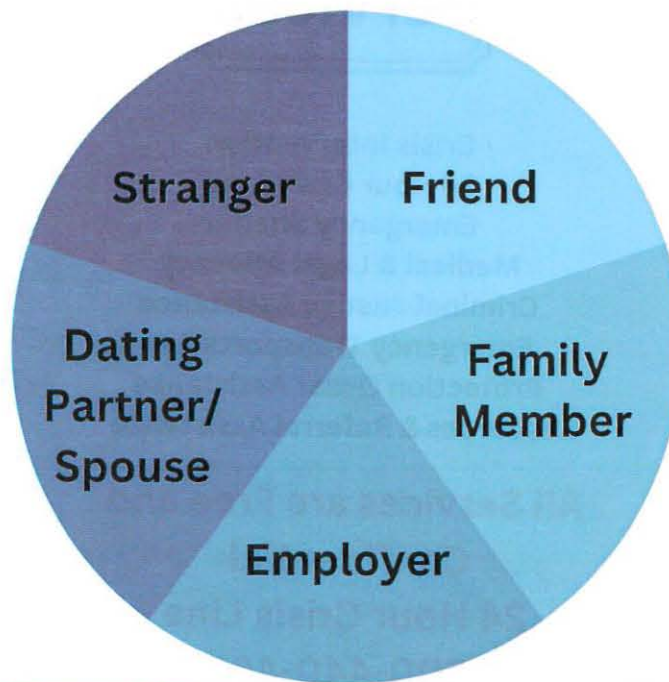
Human Trafficking is the use of force, fraud, or coercion to obtain some type of labor or commercial sex act.



If a person is being forced to work or have any kind of sexual relations for someone else's benefit such as money, food, housing, drugs ect.

Who is the Trafficker

Anyone can be a trafficker!



Signs of Human Trafficking

- Visible Injuries
- Branding Tattoos
- Not having access to own documents such as ID, Social Security card, birth certificate, etc.
- Coming into money with no explanation
- Unsafe living conditions
- Someone will speak for them
- Appearing, fearful, submissive, tense or paranoid
